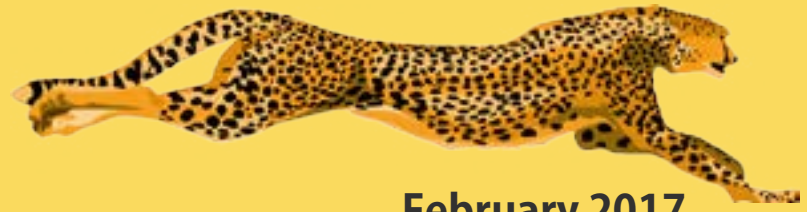

A Message From Principal Dave McCall:

Chatfield Families,

Kindergarten Roundup is coming soon! Kindergarten Roundup will be held on March 10th 8:30-3:00. (This is a teacher workday no school for students) Come any time during those hours to register your child.

We will need a proof of residence, (can be an electric bill, water bill, lease agreement, or auto registration) current immunization record and a Birth Certificate from the state. A birth certificate can be obtained at the: Mesa County Health department, Vital Records, 510 29 ½ Rd, Grand Junction, Co

If you are School of Choice you must register at your home school first. If you are accepted we will notify you and have the paper work transferred. The school of choice approval will not happen until sometime in April.

Children must be five by July 15th to register for kindergarten.

Picking Students Up Early

When you need to check your child out early for any reason, please give yourself enough time to come into the office to sign them out. Remember, every 5 tardies equals one absence. Try to avoid missing class time, whether it's at the beginning of the day or by being pulled out early. Medication at school

In the event that a medication is required to be given during school hours, all prescription medication must have written orders from the student's physician with a parent signature. The medication must be in the original pharmacy package with the original pharmacy label. All over-the-counter medication (including cough drops) must have a parent signature and be in the original packaging. Unless all these requirements are met, medication will not be administered at school.

Please DO NOT send any medication to school with your student. A parent/guardian must bring the medication to school.

Lost and Found
